Week # 1 August 30 to September 2, 2011

Topics/Content/Skills:

Circle time/Morning Meeting:

Students will be introduced to Parkside's motto, Pledge of Allegiance, Pledge to Christian Flag, the Lord's Prayer, Worship, daily prayer, class schedule, calendar, weather chart, classroom jobs, and sharing our feelings.

Reading: Identifying everyday words

Math: How many letters in my name, How many days in school, calendar, Review Shapes, Trace shapes, shapes are everywhere, Graphing our birthdays

Bible: Who is God?, The Bible; the Lord's Prayer

Phonics: Learning letter song, review letter and sound

Literature: Teacher will engage students in read-aloud of texts that could include: "The Kissing hands", "Chrysanthemum", "Mrs. Bindergarten Gets Ready for Kindergarten," "My First Day at School", "We go to school", "Pooh's First Day of School," "Curious George Goes to School", or "First Day Jitters".

Writing: Students will engage in interactive writing by composing journal entry (and illustrating) about what they did during the summer. Write your name, Write the alphabet, and Write the numbers.

Social Studies: Students will engage in get-to-know-you activities, including: knowing classmates' names, knowing teacher's names, community building energizer. Students will learn classroom expectations. Students will cooperatively create with teacher 5 classroom rules. Activity: Know the rules (differentiate between school rules and house rules). Students will be introduced to an explained classroom behavior tool. They will also be naming the days of the week and months of the year.

Science: Theme- Wonderful me- Who am ?

Vocabulary Words: Corresponds to the monthly theme
