MONDAY	<p>1)Review equivalent fractions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Teacher will first explain what a fraction (part of a whole) is. Peeled orange will be used to demonstrate. ▪ EQUIVALENT FRACTIONS <p>Teacher will break the peeled orange in half to show that that $\frac{1}{2}$ of the orange is equal to for e.g. $\frac{3}{6}$</p> <p>More equivalent fractions will be written on the board e.g. $\frac{1}{2}=\frac{2}{4}=\frac{3}{6}=\frac{4}{8}$ etc. so students can identify the pattern and as a result find equivalent fractions $\frac{1}{3}=\frac{3}{9}=\frac{9}{27}$)</p> <p>PRACTICE: Students will be asked to find 3 equivalent fractions for $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{5}$, $\frac{6}{10}$</p>	Workbook pg. 67
