Theme: The Earth

November School Wide Memory Verse:

Topics/Content/Skills

Bible—The 10 Commandments show us God's Way

- God desires to reveal His righteousness
- God's laws and commands are perfect, right and good
- People should obey God's law
- Scripture Text: Exodus 20:1-17; 24:7
- Memory Verse: Romans 7:12

Poetry: Katalina Matalina

- We will use this silly poem to help us use "Making a Mental Image" as a comprehension strategy.
- High frequency Words added to the Word Wall: her, she, had, were

READING/Literacy in Life (AKA science):

- Hands-on exploration and nonfiction books will help us learn facts about the Earth.
 - The Earth is a sphere covered with soil and water.
 - Under the soil and water (the Earth's crust) is rock.
 - Wind, Water, and People change the surface of the Earth.
- Chapter book: *The Pagemaster*

Writing:

- This week we will look at all we have written since the beginning of the year. As a group we'll discuss "What made the books easy/good to read?" and "What made the books hard to read."
- Our discussion of what has worked in our writing and what hasn't will give us new insights into the conventions we practiced last week—write clearly and carefully, use spaces, use capitals at the beginning of a sentence, and use ending punctuation.
- Students will keep practicing appropriate conventions in their writing either through the journal format or through Small Moments books.

Spelling

- Students will work in one of three spelling groups based on their instructional needs:
 - Group 1—Comparing the letters N and P at the beginning of words (nut, nose, net, pan, pig, pot)
 - Group 2—Comparing the –eg Family, -et and –en Family (net, hen, leg)
 - Group 3—Comparing short vowels with final digraphs (math, path, wish, much)

Math

- Calendar activities will continue to focus on mathematical concepts such as:
 - Odd and even numbers
 - Skip counting by 2s, 5s, and 10s
 - More, less, the same
- Addition Strategy: Number Bonds (aka part-part-whole). A number bond is a mental picture of the relationship between a number and the parts that combine to make it.
