K0	In review, we remembered that red and blue make purple, red and yellow make orange and that blue and yellow make green. The kids used brown paper and black crayon to draw trees and tree trunks. This week we will mix blue and yellow to make green using tempera paint and sponges to create leaves on our trees.		
K1 K2	<p>Whoo-hoo! We finished mixing colors! What began as three colors has become six! We made purple, orange and green! Now students of K2 are ready learn how they are placed on a color wheel.</p> <p>This week they will receive a copy of a color wheel and they will learn where the colors are positioned on a color wheel as they write the correct color word in each of the six parts.
