Topics/Content/Skills:

Phonics: Students will be introduced to compound words. They will learn how two words are formed to create one new word. They will also learn how to divide words into their syllables.

Writing: This week students will learn the 5 steps of writing and apply in their Personal Story.

Social Studies: Students will be introduced to Chapter 2, the different types of communities (Urban, Suburban and Rural) and the functions.
