Theme: Leaves

Topics/Content/Skills

Bible—All people are born sinners and alienated from God

- All people are descendants of Adam and Eve
- All people are born sinful and separated from God
- All people are deserving of God's punishment of death
- God is patient with sinners
- Scripture Text: Deut. 7:9, Psalm 90:2; Psalm 103:13-14; Psalm 115:3; Psalm 119:137
- Memory Verse: Romans 6:23

Poetry:

- "Down, Down"
- Lifetime words added to the word wall: are; Direction words—up, down, around, over

READING/Literacy in Life (AKA science):

- Our main text this week will be *A Tree for All Seasons*. We will use this book to launch our study of leaves.
- We will compare picture cards and sort them by fact or fiction.
- We will classify and compare leaves by looking closely at their attributes.
- We will "share the pen" as a class and create a diagram of how a tree might look during each of the four seasons.
- Chapter book: *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*

Writing:

- Last week students began writing their first Small Moments Story. Students will put the finishing touches on their books, bind them, practice reading them and then share them with the class.
- After students have finished Book 1 of their Small Moments Story, they will begin the process over for Book 2—think of what to write about, plan the beginning, middle, and end on their Small Moments Planner, write their book, practice reading it, and then share it with the class.

Daily 5:

- Read to Self: The class will continue practicing appropriate Read to Self behaviors in order to build our reading stamina. Our goal is 15 minutes by the middle of October.
- Read to Someone: The class will continue practicing appropriate Read to Someone behaviors
- Word Work: New elements of Word Work will continue to be introduced and routines for using and learning with Word Work materials practiced.
- Spelling: Last week time was our enemy! We will try again sorting picture cards that rhyme with clock, fly, and pan

Math

- Our study of leaves will be integrated into many of our math activities this week. We will use our leaves to measure, sort, and create patterns.
- We will continue our math conversations on comparing numbers using the math vocabulary of more and fewer.
- During our Calendar time, we will focus on the “Tricky Teen” numbers.

Reading	<p>Snuggle up and read to/with your child for at least 15 min.</p> <p>If you read a fiction book with your child, check for comprehension by asking the WHO the story is about and WHAT happened in the story (we call this Check For Understanding)</p> <p>If you read a nonfiction text with your child, ask your child to tell you one thing they learned about the subject.</p> <p>Fill in the reading log and return it in your child's folder on Friday.</p>			
Bible	Practice Memorizing Romans 6:23. Students will recite their verse to me in class on Friday.			
Poetry	NO School	<p>Read through the poem. Down, brown, and town all rhyme. On a separate piece of paper, using your best handwriting, carefully write “Down” “town” and “brown.” Now write two more words that rhyme with down. Parents please help your child sound out the words, instead of just telling them the letters.</p> <p>Parent Initial__</p>	<p>Read through the poem. Circle the word “are” on the poem. Using print from magazines, newspapers, etc. be a letter detective and find the letters in the word “are”, cut them out, and glue/tape them onto the bottom of the poem. HINT: look for big letters so that it is not frustrating to cut out.</p> <p>Parent Initial__</p>	<p>Read through the poem together. Go for a leaf hunt and find at least three leaves. Glue them to a paper and have your child label them by writing what color they are on the paper.</p> <p>Parent Initial__</p>
